




1. Download and install the app 4stream from App store/google play.
2. Connect the DAC to your amplifier and start the DAC. Wait for a few seconds until you hear that the DAC is in setup mode.
3. Open the settings on your handheld device. And tap on WiFi.

You should get the list with available access points.





Choose A31Audio\_xxxx from the list and connect.




Connected with no internet connection is OK.


Now open the 4stream app and your device should be present on the screen.





Tap on + on the up right corner. The app searches now your wifi network for available access points.

Choose from the list of available networks and tap continue.





Enter your password and tap continue.
